Fishing License (Friendly Reminder)

Information and Purchase of Licenses can be taken care of on-line @ www.wildohio.org

Those over the age of 16 are required to have on their possession a valid state of Ohio Fishing License to fish or assist in fishing, touch rods, poles, bait, fish... well you get the idea.

A One-Day License for an Ohio State Resident is \$11.00 (6 month residence, age 16 to 65)

An Annual License for an Ohio State Resident is \$19.00 – (I got mine @ Gander Mountain)

An Annual Senior License for an Ohio State Resident is \$10.00 (age 66 and above)

Drug Mart in Avon on the corner of Detroit & Lear – Sell Fishing Licenses

Wal-Mart in Avon on Chester Road near the Corner of RT83 & Chester – Sell Fishing Licenses

When to Arrive:

NO earlier than 8:00 am, that is when the park opens. After check in, pick up your bait, log sheet and start catching fish.

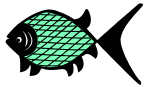

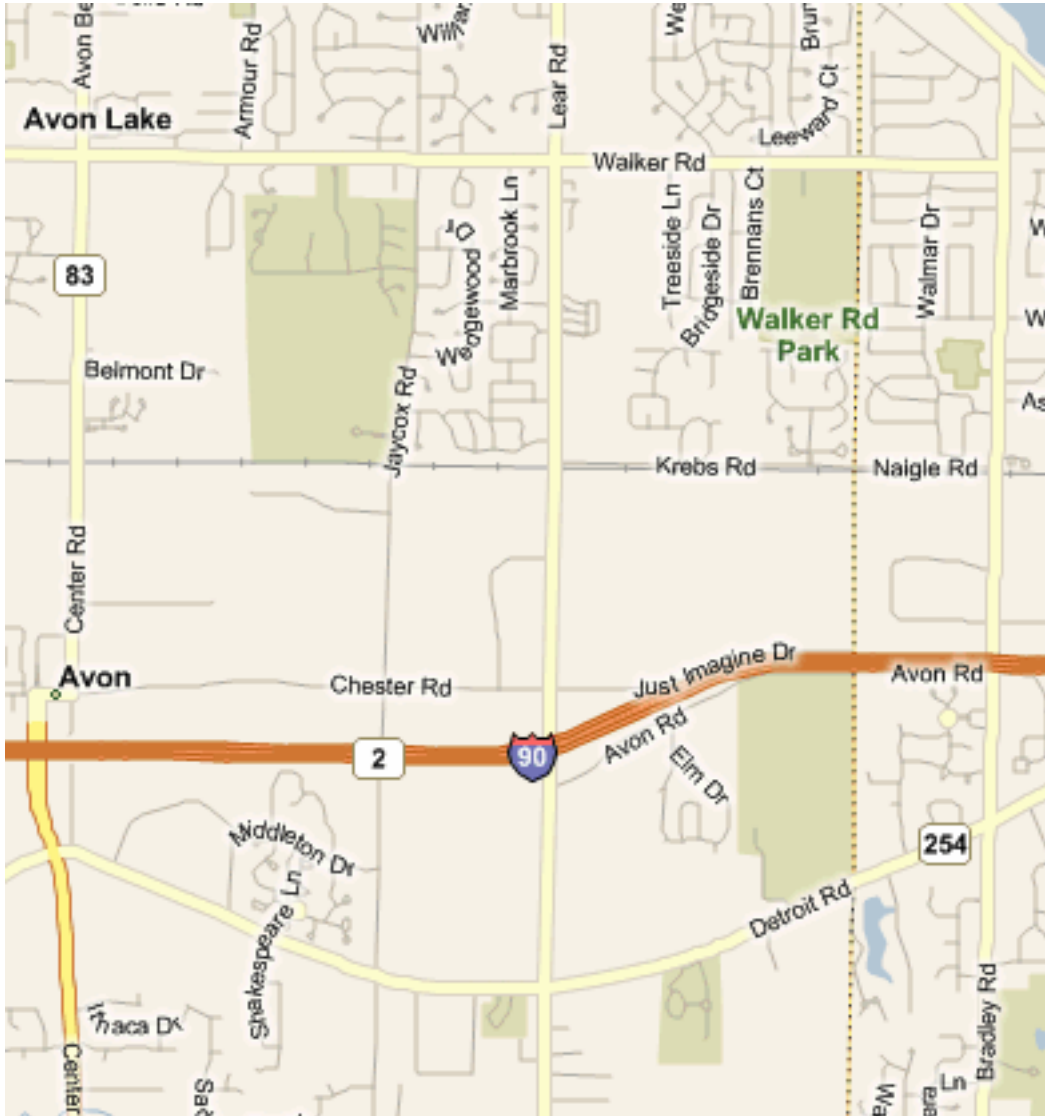

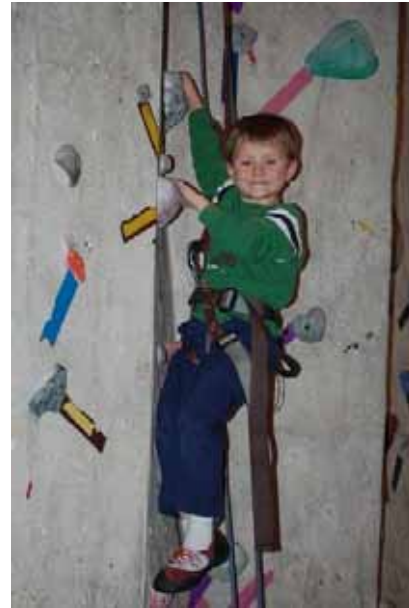
Map & Directions to Walker Road Park in Avon Lake



Directions from the South (Avon):

Take 83 North to Walker Road in Avon Lake and take a right (head East). Go straight through the light @ Jaycox Road, and the light @ Lear Road. On your right just before the Bay Village Border there will be a small sign for Walker Road Park, turn in and follow the road back to the parking lot at the pond near the pavilion.

An Alternate Route is: Detroit Road East (past Jaycox Road) to Lear road (Holy Trinity Church and Drug Mart at the corner). Turn left (North) on Lear Road, pass through the stop sign at Chester Road, over the railroad tracks and straight into Avon Lake. Take a right (head East) at the light onto Walker Road. On your right just before the Bay Village Border there will be a small sign for Walker Road Park, turn in and follow the road back to the parking lot at the pond near the pavilion.
